

The publication of this newsletter sees the club events pretty much winding down for the year. Only a few remaining on the schedule.



I hope 2023 was a year to remember!



At the club summer picnic, which was graciously hosted by Janet and Ray Medley, Jan served up her Key Lime Pie at unanimous rave reviews. Jan has consented to share her almost world-famous dessert with the club members. Enjoy!!

AWESOME **Key Lime Pie** Key Lime Pie is a classic summer dessert that will transport you to a tropical climate with each delicious bite! Tastier and fresher than anything you can buy at a store, this is a homemade confection guaranteed to delight you; it's tangy, creamy, and oh-so-indulgent. Best of all, it only takes 30 minutes to make! Serve this yummy Key Lime Pie chilled with a bit of lime zest on top for a transformative dessert experience! Ingredients For the crust: 1 1/2 cups graham cracker crumbs 1/3 cup granulated sugar 6 tablespoons butter, melted For the pie filling: · 28 ounces condensed milk, sweetened 3/4 cup key lime juice (JUST SHY OF 3/4 C + MAKE UP W/FRESH LIME JUICE) 1/2 cup light sour cream · 2 limes or 4 key limes, zested, plus more for topping For the topping: · 1 cup heavy whipping cream 1/2 cup powdered sugar 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

#### Directions

- 1. Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F.
- 2. In a small bowl, mix together the graham cracker crumbs, granulated sugar, and butter.
- 3. Press the mixture into a pie pan and bake for 7 minutes.
- 4. Cool the pie pan for 30 minutes.
- 5. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F.
- 6. In a medium bowl, whisk together the sweetened condensed milk, sour cream, lime juice, and lime zest.
- 7. Pour the mixture into the crust and bake for 10 minutes.
- 8. Allow the pie to cool and chill for 3 hours in the fridge.
- When the pie has completed chilling, beat the heavy cream and powdered sugar together until stiff peaks form, using a mixer to assist.
- 10. Beat in the vanilla.
- 11. Spread the whipped cream atop the pie and add more lime zest.
- 12. Serve!




