

Tech Tip!


Tires

If you've had the front end completely rebuilt or restored (fresh parts, proper wheel balance, and alignment) and still notice a vibration, try this: There might be pebbles lodged in the tires. Check your tire treads for small stones. By the way, you should also consider washing the dirt, grime, and rocks from the inside of your wheels so the balance won't be affected. Also, look for missing wheel weights, and have your wheels rebalanced. (trick of mine, I mark where the wheel weights are) in case I throw one.

IF YOU REMOVE YOUR WHEELS FROM THE CAR ALWAYS TORQUE THE LUG NUTS TO PROPER SPEC.

Corvette Pace Car Registry information and history:

Originally established in 1994 by Stu Robbins and Dennis Riddell, the Registry was reorganized during the first Pace Car Reunion held at the National Corvette Museum in October, 2001. The Chevrolet Corvette Pace Car Registry is now intended as a gathering place for owners and enthusiasts of *all* Corvette Pace Cars.

Here are some of their guiding principles:

- We are seeking affiliation with owners of all Corvette Pace Cars, especially those that have participated in the Indianapolis 500 race.
- All owners of Corvette Indy Pace Cars are welcome, especially, but not limited to the 6 years (1978, 1986, 1995, 1998, 2007, and 2008) in which official replicas were produced by General Motors.
- While there were no replicas produced by GM, we welcome owners of Corvettes which are faithful reproductions of the Pace Cars used in Indianapolis in Corvette Pace Car-designated years. This includes 2003 50th Anniversary cars, with factory-produced 2002 Indy Pace Car decals, and authenticated replicas of other years (such as 2004, 2005, and 2006) and now into current years.
- Owners of Indy Festival/Dealer Promotion Corvettes, as well as others interested in Corvette Pace Cars, are also welcome as members of the Chevrolet Corvette Pace Car Registry.

The Registry is a proud family of Corvette Pace Car enthusiasts; and Registry's idea is to be more rather than less inclusive for Corvette Pace Cars, to document all members' cars, and to keep track of as many of these specialty Corvettes as we can. Ultimately, the information will be of use to the National Corvette Museum, which we support, and to members who wish to know about the origins and history of their Corvette Pace Cars.

We have a database of over 1300 strong for the record and for future owners who will be interested in the provenance of your Pace Car. We also plan to pass this information on to the National Corvette Museum archives.
