#### 2017 Year in Review

November 2016, the annual meeting of OCC saw the election of officers and directors for the following year. The results were Jeff Myers, president; Ron Giese, Vice president; Carie Drennan, Secretary, Sue Giese, Treasurer. The directors were Gregg Goetz, Mark Hobler, and Pat Murray. Carie and Dana Drennen moved to Iowa, and Sue Montana-Myers agreed to be the interim secretary the club made our annual contribution to Ozaukee Family Sharing for their Thanksgiving and Christmas food programs.

December 2016 the club ended the year with 87 members owning 50 Corvettes. The Holidays are upon us, our snowbird members are settling into life in warmer climates as our Corvettes are put away for another winter.

January 2017 the club had their Christmas Party at M.J. Stevens, and a great time was had by the 42 members that attended. We had an unusual Christmas present exchange that almost everyone seemed to enjoy.






