Thanks Pat Murray for this Tech Tip.

Here is a tech tip I learned today. Over the last week I have been trying to program the Home link (3 small buttons) for the garage door opener in the new C8 to no avail. I finally called Home Link and the answer is if you replaced your bulbs in the garage door opener with LED's it could cause interference (RF) enough that it will not work. I replaced the LED's with regular bulbs and the Home Link works fine now. Never would have guessed that.

CALL TO ORDER: Pat M @ 6:00pm;

TREASURER'S REPORT: All bill are current with adequate funds. OCC will make a donation to Mel's Charities, W61 N297, Cedarburg, WI 53012 in the amount of \$50 in memory of Wayne Houpt. Accepted 1. Greg 2. Bruce.

SECRETARY REPORT/REVIEW AND ACCEPTANCE OF PRIOR MEETING MINUTES: February minutes were reviewed and approved. 1. Greg 2. Bruce.

MEMBERSHIP REPORT: We are starting the active part of the year with 68 members. See New Business 6.

ADVERTISING REPORT: We are pleased to have 15 advertisers. Brought up topic of charging for printed copies of the newsletter sent to them. We feel there is more value in the electronic copy which contains hyperlinks from the advertisement itself to their chosen landing page. Discussion item for later this year.

WEBSITE REPORT: Pat shared web stats. So far in 2021 we've had 2,062 unique visitors to our website; 3,421 unique visits; 37,797 hits (search engine). For year ending 2020 we had 8,634 unique visitors; 14,728 visits; 328,045 hits (search engine)

SUNSHINE COMMITTEE: We discussed how OCC should most appropriately recognize the passing of Wayne Houpt (founder of Wayne's drive in). The club will make a \$50 donation to MELS Charities.

OLD BUSINESS:

PO Box. Rich closed the old PO Box 80632 and opened the much less expensive 80171.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. Adopt-A-Highway has requested the club take and submit to them several action shots they can use in promoting the Adopt-A-Highway program. We'll make sure members participating are aware of that.
- 2. Trip Around the Lake (FondeVettes). This is the 50th year of this event. We want to make sure members are aware as this could be a nice year to participate.
- 3. We have entered OCC in the West Bend parade meeting up at the usual spot on Main Street at 8:00am. Ron suggested we meet for lunch afterwards.
- 4. With parades coming up Jim reminded the board that we need to add coverages for this with our insurance policy. We should become aware of any other summer parades before then so the week before the parade we'll add appropriate coverages for our intended participation in events.
- 5. Ron and Sue have been storing OCC materials in the spacious home. They are moving to West Bend this summer and need to find a storage place for club materials (or potentially the club rent a small storage place in the area). Jim to get Ron info on a Grafton location they know of. So if we don't find a member to hold these for the club; we'll look into a rented storage option.

- 6. Ron showed a club nametag with a label added reading "new member" below their name. The label can be peeled off whenever the new member feels they've met enough members to no longer feel "new". This is how he plans to prepare new nametags going forward.
- 7. Adopt-a-Highway planned for April 10th (multiple rain dates).
- 8. Pat suggests we be prepared in May to discuss and vote on bylaw changes. Essentially lowering the % present requirement to a lower number. Mark suggested we consider the voting metric to be based on members present at the meeting rather than total membership. Jim will work with Pat before the meeting to draft how the change would appear.
- 9. Discussed timing of OCC Board meetings to not conflict with Wednesday's at Wayne's over the summer. The second Thursday of each month starting in May will be our meeting at FlipSide meeting room. We will plan to have dinner at 5:00 for those who wish, and start the meeting promptly at 6:00.
- 10. Bruce brought up the idea that we have some sort of summer event this year to replace our club Christmas party we didn't have in January. We selected August 7th as the date; but details of what it will be TBD. Bruce would prefer we avoid a "Christmas in July" sort of theme. It appeared most agreed.

Next OCC Board Meeting will be on May 13, 2021 at FlipSide's back room. Dinner at 5:00; Meeting at 6:00.




