



Member's Spotlight

<u>Rich Witkowski and Jim Nowlen 87 Vette</u>: We bought our Corvette while searching for a Miata for Jim to Autocross. We had found a good candidate Miata up in Neenah and decided to drive up there on a Sunday so as to avoid any salesman pressure. When we got there we looked over that Green Miata, but next to it, up on a display ramp, was a bright yellow Corvette. We looked that over pretty thoroughly as well.

On our way home we talked about both cars and before we got home arrived at a plan of offering a "twofer" deal. First thing Monday morning Jim called them, spoke with sales manager and asked about both cars. Then posed the topic of making our deal. That was accepted and so that evening we drove back up to test drive and then close on the two cars. We took our brother in law along so we got all three vehicles back home.

That began a journey. "Charly", the name Rich gave our Corvette, had a fair amount of deferred maintenance. Tires were 20 years old and rubber was rather unforgiving. Fluids were old, and a tune-up was overdue. One of the seven other owners put in a Sony radio that just looked awful on the dash. And the interior had long since perished. We got temporary covers for the seats to get us through the first couple of years. Finally by the end of 2018 all of the various maintenance issues had been attended to and it was time to address the interior. We were never particularly fond of the graphite color interior and after getting samples of options, decided upon Light Saddle as the new interior color. As there were no redeeming value in the original interior, replacing it all made the most sense. Thus, color really didn't matter.

Around Thanksgiving 2018 Jim ordered all the components we thought we needed from Corvette America. Matt Vroman there was terrific and pointed out that most owners find parts needed once they open things up; and kept an open order on file so that add-ons were easy to do. He was correct...

We tackled the project in late March 2019, setting up our garage as a surgical suite and organizing tools, workspace, new parts, "cleaned up for reuse" parts, and disposal part pile (which we kept on hand until the entire project was done). When we pulled the seats we found lots of glass; and that along with other clues let us know that at a point this car had been broken into; and much of the dash literally ripped out.

Perhaps the funniest part of the project came with carpeting the under dash panels. Jim crawled in head facing up, feet to back of car, head all the way to the pedals to reinstall that part; only to find there was no place to grab to pull himself out. Rich had to extract him feet first. Undaunted, we repeated that three more times. 3

After install there were a few electrical things we had Corvette Sports handle for us related to that break-in years before; and finally a complete paint touchup and polish at Falls Uptown Motors; not far from Corvette Sports. Custom aluminum dash panel was made at MI Metal Finishing in Belgium.
