TECH TIP:

Low Tire Pressure Light

Tire Pressure Monitoring System (TPMS) is a warning system that warns you of an unsafe change in pressure in one or more of the tires. The warning is provided by pressure sensing transmitters mounted inside each tire.

Steep temperature drops can trigger the low tire pressure warning light. When the low tire pressure light comes on, your car is simply telling you that more air is needed in your tire(s). Some TPMS systems can alert you when the tire pressures are too high as well.

If the tire pressure is low, add air until it reaches the proper pressure as soon as possible. Follow the inflation pressure recommendations listed in your vehicle owner's manual or on the tire information label located in the glove box or on the driver's door jamb. If the light continues to stay on, have the tire(s) check for possible tire damage or a faulty TPMS sensor.

TREASURER'S REPORT: All bill are current with adequate funds. OCC will have a check ready for Boy Scout Troop 780 for \$50 for carrying our club banner in the West Bend Memorial Day Parade. Accepted 1. Dave 2. Ron.

SECRETARY REPORT/REVIEW AND ACCEPTANCE OF PRIOR MEETING MINUTES: February minutes were reviewed and approved. 1. Larry 2. Sally.

MEMBERSHIP REPORT: We have 68 members although we might have two interested after Wayne's opening Corvette night.

ADVERTISING REPORT: No change as of the meeting although one new advertiser, Philleo Insurance Agency (which is our agent for the club policy) has indicated they are in for a double business card ad.

WEBSITE REPORT: Pat shared web stats. So far in 2021 we've had 3,146 unique visitors to our website; 5,206 unique visits; 55,948 hits (search engine). For year ending 2020 we had 8,634 unique visitors; 14,728 visits; 328,045 hits (search engine)

ROAD TRIPS: 22 Members in 11 Corvettes participated in the Spring Shakedown Cruise to Gus' Drive-In in East Troy. Our route south took us through the Kettle Moraine with and intermediate stop at Blue Collar Coffee (formerly Milwaukee Street Traders) in Delafield. Both venues received a thumb's up rating from the group. Upcoming driving events include a breakfast drive-out to Whispering Orchards Cafe in Cleveland, WI on May 15 or 16, a Thursday dinner drive-out to the 5 O'Clock Club in Pewaukee on May 27th, participation in the West Bend Memorial Day Parade on May 31st. and participation in the Fondy Vette's 50th Annual Trip Around Lake Winnebago on June 6th. Road trips are becoming a very popular part of the club activities, especially for the new members which are frequently new Corvette owners - they bought 'em to drive 'em.

- 6. Reminder: OCC Board will meet the second Thursday of each month starting in May will be our meeting at FlipSide meeting room. We will plan to have dinner at 5:00 for those who wish, and start the meeting promptly at 6:00.
